221 POLICY

Delegations and Representations to the Board of Education

As a vehicle for affirming its policy of open Board-community relations and to make their views known to the Board, individuals or delegations are welcome to express such views at regular Board meetings, subject to the following guidelines:

- 1. Representations, requests or proposals of system-wide relevance should be initially brought to the Superintendent or designate, then to the Board, if necessary, in the manner specified in Section 4 of this policy.
- 2. Matters relative to an individual school should be discussed first with the principal of that school.
- 3. If the matter cannot be resolved at the school it should then be brought to the Superintendent or designate.
- 4. If the matter cannot be resolved with the Superintendent, it should then be brought to the Board in the following manner:
 - a) An appointment to meet with the Board must be established, through the Superintendent at least one week prior to the meeting.
 - b) Questions and problems should be submitted, in writing, at the time of the request for an appointment.
 - c) At the meeting, the individual or delegation will ordinarily be expected to limit any presentation to 10 minutes, followed by questions and comments from trustees.
 - d) The Board will at that time ordinarily take such questions or problems under advisement, and will take action after due deliberation, usually at a subsequent meeting.
 - e) If circumstances warrant, the Board may receive such individuals or delegations "in-camera".
