Dear Parents and Staff,

As you are aware, several individuals had tested positive for COVID-19 at Promontory Heights Elementary School, 46200 Stoneview Dr, Chilliwack

Public Health has worked with the school and school district to complete contact tracing and has taken the necessary steps to protect the school community. This included:

- Requiring staff and students from the impacted grades to self isolate in order to prevent additional spread of COVID-19 through staff and students.
- Reviewing the School's safety plans, including a site visit prior to school re-opening.

Public Health continues to support the school in preventing COVID-19 spread. At this time, most individuals will have completed or be nearing the end of their isolation period. As such, the school will be able to safely re-open on October 4, 2021.

If you have not been contacted by Public Health, **there is no direct exposure risk at this time.** Continue with your daily health checks prior to attending school.

We ask you to:

- Please continue to send your child to school
- Continue using the Daily Health Check supplied by your school to monitor your child for symptoms as per usual.

For privacy reasons, we cannot give out any specific details on the COVID-19 exposure other than the information provided above.

COVID-19 cases at schools are a direct reflection of community spread, therefore it is important everyone follow Public Health advice to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19. This includes practicing good hand hygiene, physically distancing, wearing a mask in indoor public spaces, getting tested if you have any symptoms and isolating from others when you are unwell.

As a reminder, if staff, parents or students haven't received their COVID-19 vaccine and are eligible, please ensure to [register for your COVID-19 vaccine](#). You only need to register once. Receiving the COVID-19 vaccine will help protect you, your family, the school community and the general public in the spread of COVID-19.

Staff and Students who are Eligible for COVID-19 Vaccine

Staff and students are able to receive their COVID-19 vaccine if they have no symptoms of COVID-19, are eligible for the vaccine, and are not recommended to self-isolate by Public Health.

Eligible staff and students who haven't registered for their COVID-19 immunization, you can register at getvaccinated.gov.bc.ca or call: 1-833-838-2323 from 7 am to 7 pm daily. Translators are available. You only need to register once.
