- Quantity and Frequency to <u>QUALITY</u>




We don't diagnose students to find out what is *WRONG* with them.





- o Elementary K & Grade 3
- Middle Grade 6
- Secondary Grade 9
- All NEW students to be CB-IEPs (new to district and new to Ministry designation)
- o Remaining students with regular IEP remain ACTIVE with a 2024 end date
- When student leaves district, clerical *must* notify Lisa Ball so she can activate IEP for receiving district
- Designation List is critical maintain at SS and G4 or Electronic G4
- o MUST make hard copy for G4 file each year

- Elementary K & Grade 3
- Middle Grade 6
