REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADES K - 12

Linear (Elementary, Middle, some Secondary):

- Two Written Learning Updates (Terms 1 & 2)
- Two Informal Learning Updates
- One Summary of Learning (Term 3)

Semester (Secondary only):

- Two Written Learning Updates (Term 1 & 3)
- Two Informal Learning Updates
- One Summary of Learning with Graduation Status Update(Term 2 & 4)


Communication of student learning in relation to the learning standards or individualized learning goals outlined in their IEP, using the proficiency scale for K-9, letter grades for 10 - 12.

Descriptive Feedback to describe student strengths, identify areas for future growth, and suggest opportunities for further development provided from school and home.

Information about student attendance.

Student generated content, including student self-reflection on the Core Competencies and goal setting.

IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE



2022 - 2023

- Regular meetings with Principals and Vice Principals regarding upcoming changes and impact for teachers and students.
- Pilot classrooms using Proficiency Scales in Secondary School
- Professional learning for grade 9 12 teachers on Proficiency Scales and Descriptive Feedback
- Educators were provided with a summary document for communicating student learning including exemplars for personalizing comments.

2023 - 2024

- Updated K-12 Student Reporting Policy
- P/VP meetings regarding changes and implications for students with CBIEPs

GRADES K-9 PROFICIENCY SCALE



Emerging: The student demonstrates an initial understanding of the concepts and competencies relevant to the expected learning.

Developing: The student demonstrates a partial understanding of the concepts and competencies relevant to the expected learning.

Proficient: The student demonstrates a complete understanding of the concepts and competencies relevant to the expected learning.

Extending: the student demonstrates a sophisticated understanding of the concepts and competencies relevant to the expected learning.
