

## WHAT IS FESL

The Framework for Enhancing Student **Learning** is about making sure **every** student in B.C. has the chance to succeed, especially Indigenous learners, children and youth in care, and students with disabilities or diverse abilities. It emphasizes working in real partnership with First Nations, Indigenous Peoples, and education partners, and building public **trust** by providing high-quality education and being open about results. The focus is on continuous improvement—learning from data, addressing challenges, and building capacity across the system.

## WHAT IS THE FESL REPORT?

- Provincial Requirement All districts must submit Enhancing Student Learning (FESL) and Interim Progress Reports annually between June 30 and September 30.
- Continuous Improvement The report tracks where we are, identifies trends, and guides next steps over time.
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## WHAT IS THE FESL REPORT?

- Transparent and Reliable Data –
   Emphasizes data integrity, using consistent and trustworthy measures across the province.
- Strategic Plan Alignment Connects directly to district goals in literacy, numeracy, well-being, and student transitions.
- Accountability and Learning Highlights both progress and challenges, serving as a public progress report rather than a final judgment.
